05 GIFTED AND TALENTED

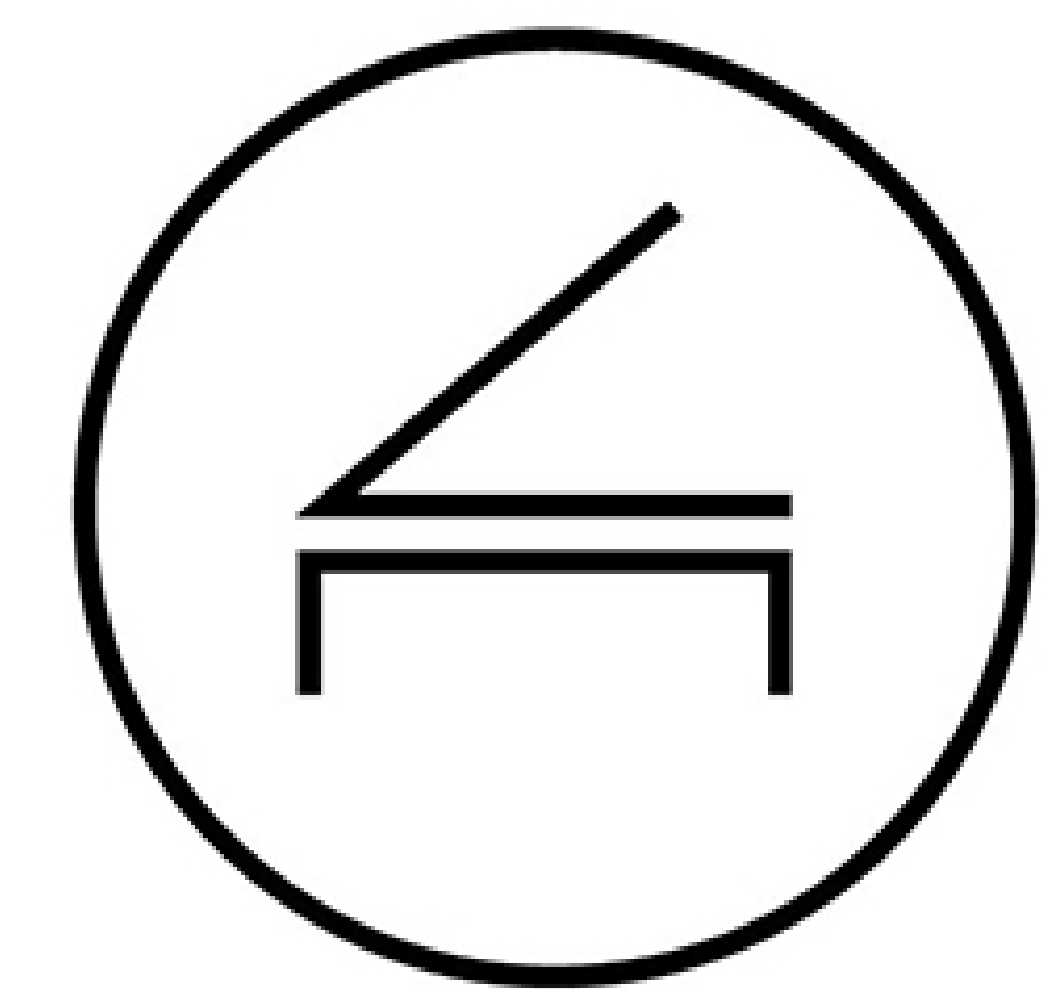
