
Nutritional Guidelines

- Child Nutrition Services is regulated by the mandates and requirements set by United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA).
- USDA set the standards for weekly menu requirements that regulate calories, sodium, and fat by age and grade levels.
- There are 5 different meal pattern components: Meat/Meat Alternates, Grains, Fruit, Vegetables (5 subgroups – Dark Green, Red/Orange, Legumes, Starchy, Other), and Milk.

Free and Reduce Applications

Student's who qualified for benefits last year, will maintain those benefits for the **FIRST** 30 days of school.

- Only ONE application per household; include all students regardless of campus on the application.
- Child Nutrition Office has 10 business days to process applications.

If a student **DID NOT** submit an application, denied benefits last year, or new student to Crowley ISD, they will need to add money to their accounts to cover meal costs.

- Breakfast- Universal FREE Breakfast
- Reduced Student Priced Lunch \$0.40
- Elementary Paid Student: \$2.80
- Secondary Schools Paid Student: \$3.05

Submitting your application for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) can do more than just provide access to free and reduced-price meals. Families must meet eligibility criteria for each program listed. Additional applications may still be needed to secure benefits.

School Meal Application



School Funding

May provide additional funding for state and federal programs and services at your school.



Athletics

May result in free or discounted fees to participate in activities.



Internet Access

May qualify you for discounted rates on internet services.

P-EBT

Determines eligibility to receive Pandemic EBT benefits.





Academic Tests

May provide reduced registration fees for AP, SAT, and/or ACT tests.





College Application Fees

May qualify you for discounted rates associated with college applications.

Establishes eligibility for free or reduced prices on delicious and nutritious meals.
