RE: GRADING SCALE FOR LETTER GRADES

The following scale shall be used to translate a letter grade to a numerical grade. The numerical grade will be used to calculate the student's grade-point average in accordance with EIC (Local).

Letter Grade	Numerical Grade
A+	98
A	95
A-	92
E	95
B+	88
B	85
B-	82
S	85
C+	78
C	75
C-	72
N	70
Any D	70
U	65
Any F	60

If the student brings a grading scale from the previous school, the numerical grade will be calculated as follows:

- For each letter grade, determine the middle of the range of the grades provided on the previous school's grading scale
- If the letter grade includes a plus (+) or minus (-), determine the numerical grades from the previous school's grading scale by
 - counting the number of grades below and above the middle grade as determined in the first step and
 - finding the mid-point of the lower and upper halves
 - Example: A student earns an A+ and the grading scale provided by the previous school indicates that an A = 93-100
 - The middle grade of 93, 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, 99, 100 is 96.5 = 97.
 - There are four grades below and three grades above with mid-points 94.5=95 and 99, respectively.
 - So the A+ will translate into a 99.
